Our scoop is approximately one cubic yard. One cubic yard of mulch covers 106' @ 3 inches thick (this is approximately an area of 10'x10')

Helpful Hints:

- Apply mulch 3-5 inches around shrubs for weed control.
- Mulch can be applied anytime of the year
- Do not put young bedding plants into freshly laid mulch due to the heat and gasses released by mulch composting. Instead, soak new mulch with water and wait five days before planting younger bedding plants.
- When planting annual flowers, push back mulch, dig a hole, put a small hand of compost with each plant and cover over with mulch. By doing this flower will do well and your bed will keep its neat and clean appearance.
- Some mulches produce excellent beds for spores of fungus as they decay, especially where your beds are moist and shaded. If fungi or mushrooms sprout, remove the fungus, scratch up the mulch (fungus only grows in compacted mulch) and sprinkle affected area with a 50/50 water and Clorox mixture. This will kill the spores without hurting your plants. Only wet the top of the mulch.
