- Our premium grades include:**
- **SPF Stud Premium**—Spruce-Pine-Fir is a high grade lumber with relatively small tight knots and very little color variation. Stud grade is the highest grade lumber.
  - **#1**—is several grades above standard
  - **SPF #2 BTR**—#2 BTR means it is of better quality than standard.
  - **Treated**—This wood is pressure treated, which creates a rugged exterior building product that is rot and insect resistant.

OSB is made from wood ground into thin wood strands, which are mixed with wax and adhesive, then hot pressed. Building codes recognize OSB and plywood as the same material. Plywood is made from thin sheets of veneer that are peeled off a log, then laminated together in a hot press. CDX is the most commonly used, standard grade construction plywood.
